The court strives for an equitable division of all joint assets and obligations; but may vary according to ability to pay and certain other factors. The following will help you decide how things might best be divided to benefit both parties and to minimize the time and expense that would be involved if you don't come to an agreement have to hire attorneys for each party and have the case tried in court before a judge who will make the decisions for you. **Remember, 95% of divorces settle out of Court - Save your assets from the lawyers and do it Now!**

REMEMBER; No one else is as concerned about your situation as you are. THIS APPLIES TO BOTH OF THE PARTIES IN THE DIVORCE ACTION! IF YOU WILL COMPROMISE A LITTLE NOW, BOTH PARTIES WILL HAVE MORE TO KEEP FOR THEMSELVES.

First, in Section I. of the next page, list all your debts - you'll be amazed at how most of your assets will be shown here because most of your assets will have a debt attached to it. Use the format shown in the following example:

Be sure to put a note at the bottom of the page explaining anything that the party who is going to be responsible for debt is not retaining as an asset or that is not obvious from the above. For Example: If the house was going to be sold and the equity after the cost of the sale is to be split 50/50 or 60/40 etc. Or, maybe the Wife was going to keep the House and refinance it to pay the Husband a cash payment of \$5,000.00 equity within 12 months or by a specific date.

Second, if there is an asset that doesn't have any debt connected to it, list that in Section II and assign a value to it also. Now, all your debts and assets are listed.

Now at the bottom of the page where you listed all your debts, list your average monthly living expenses. This will be things like rent, electric, water, telephone, auto insurance, entertainment, etc.

- 1. With No Children, No Property:** **\$199.00**
(Both parties just want to get a fresh start with no debts or assets to divide and no children common to the parties)
- 2. With No Children, No Property & Spouse is Missing - Whereabouts Unknown:** **\$259.00**
(Petitioner just wants to get a fresh start with no debts or assets to divide and no children common to the parties)
- 3. With Property, but, No Children:** **\$299.00**
(Parties may have some assets or debts acquired during the marriage that they need to divide out in the Divorce)

(Parties have children born of the marriage whether common to parties or not. (Parties may have some assets or debts acquired during the marriage that they need to divide out in the Divorce and parties can't agree on some property or debt issues. Judgment will be typed as petitioner asks.)
- 3. With Children:** **\$499.00**
(Parties have children born of the marriage whether common to parties or not and parties can't agree on some of the issues relating to children or property division. You'll probably have the other party served in this situation. Then, they'll will furnish their answer and financial info. which you'll then send to us to complete your package.)
